Thank you for your interest in an Eli Terry Jr. Middle School Leadership Position. Please read the packet thoroughly. Return the completed application to the main office.

We are looking for some dynamic, enthusiastic, and committed middle school students to apply for these leadership positions. Qualities necessary for any school leader are:

- **Leadership skills** – Are you willing to lead committees and be a representative for your school?
- **Communicative** – Are you able to share ideas with your peers?
- **Team player** – Are you willing to work with others, even if it means compromising?
- **Responsibility** – You may be responsible for running activities throughout the school and you must be reliable.
- **Commitment** – This is a year long activity and if you volunteer now, you will be expected to come to all meetings and events for the remainder of the year.

Student Ambassadors

Students On Site (SOS) - *maximum 10 students*

Students On Site serve as ambassadors and the welcoming committee for our school. Responsibilities include creating welcoming documents and media, greeting visitors (both during school hours and outside of the school day), assisting at special events, and more. SOS will meet after school.

Student Leaders - *maximum 30 students*

Student Leaders will be responsible for decision making at the school level. Responsibilities include participating various school level committees, attending training on school initiatives as well as serving as exemplary role models for other ETJMS students. Student Leaders will meet after school.

Student Council - *maximum 25 students*

Student Council will be responsible for programming throughout the school year. Responsibilities include developing and coordinating events such as dances, spirit days, student assemblies, select community service projects and more. Student Council will meet after school.

All documents must be returned to the main office by October 22, 2018 for a candidate to be eligible for a leadership position. After the applications are collected, students will be interviewed for open positions. Students will be notified of acceptance soon after the interviews have been completed.
